

We want to provide a supportive and safe environment for all people associated with the Korumburra Bowling Club. This code outlines a set of guiding principles on expected standard of behaviour for every member & visitor to our Club.

DO

- be responsible and accountable for your conduct,
- be ethical, fair and honest in all your dealings with other people
- be a positive role model by displaying self-control, respect, care and diligence towards all involved with the Club
- be courteous and respectful towards team and club members, opponents, officials and visitors and adhere to bowls etiquette,
- abide by host club rules when visiting other clubs,
- be informed, consistent, impartial, just and reasonable when dealing with others
- treat the property and facilities of the club with respect,
- contribute positively to the sporting and social activities of the club,
- always place the safety & welfare of children above other considerations,
- show respect for the cultural, social and political values of all members,
- abide by the Club's & Bowls Victoria Constitution, By-laws, Rules and Policies.
- refrain from any behaviour that may bring the game or club into disrepute

DON'T

- Verbally or physically abuse anyone or use threats or intimidation
- Bully or harass anyone
- Behave in a loud or disruptive manner, such as swearing, yelling or using language that may be offensive to others
- Use the Club premises, computers, phones, copier/printer and other facilities for unauthorised or illegal purposes
- Smoke in the Clubrooms or in areas that are not designated 'smoking areas'.
